


# Local Coffee Stops




### Alsea Acre

I made an updated mobile prototype of Alsea Acre's website. I wanted to keep it warm and friendly because this company loves to connect personally with their buyer's.






# Northwest Expeditions

### Keizer Homegrown Theatre


#### Website Redesign

This is a redesign of their logo. I decided to go with a similar color scheme to what you would see at the creek. I then wanted to created the sense of balance and harmony.










### Bookstore Icons
